Release v3.1 (12-October-2009)

Highlights:

- 10.6 Snow Leopard compatibility
 - Lots of small bugs fixes and other tweaks.
 - A new version of Vine Server (v3.11) has also been included (see the Vine Server Release Notes for full details).

Bug Fixes / Tweaks:

- Added specific workaround to detect UltraVNC-SC and bypass its protocol errors.
 - NOTE: Movies recorded will not play on Snow Leopard (but will play on older Mac OS X systems).

Release v3.0 (17-December-2007)

Highlights:

- Full Screen Mode provides a more direct "immersive" experience of the remote system.
 - Control Panel with basic controls for toggling Full Screen, Live Mode, and Scaling. This is particularly helpful when working in Full Screen mode.
 - International Keyboard Support (with Vine Server 3.0).
 - User Name Login Support for connecting to UltraVNC servers (on Windows).
 - Lots of small bugs fixes and other tweaks.
 - A new version of Vine Server (v3.0) has also been included (see the Vine Server Release Notes for full details).

Bug Fixes / Tweaks:

- Can now disable checking for servers via Bonjour.
 - Fixed a problem with the Connect button not always becoming enabled after a Disconnect.
 - Wont work with ARD configured to allow VNC passwords.
 - Fixed a memory leak when checking server availability status.
 - Achieved version number parity with Vine Server.

Release v1.2 (1-August-2007)

Highlights:

- Reverse Connections (and other connections) can now have a color depth specified without disconnecting.
 - Settings for a Bonjour server (e.g. Scale To Fit) are now stored when customized.
 - Added a toolbar item to view and set the cursor location.
 - Lots of small bugs fixed and other tweaks.
 - A new version of Vine Server (v2.2) has also been included, which supports improvements to file copying to and from Vine Viewer and improved default security settings (see the Vine Server Release Notes for full details).

Bug Fixes / Tweaks:

- Fixed a display problem when the Mouse Right Click Key preference was set to "None".
 - Fixed memory leaks on remote connections.
 - Fixed some problems with attempting to update toolbar items improperly from a secondary thread.
 - Fixed context menus in the Connection List.
 - Fixed several clipboard transfer bugs relating to the active window.
 - Fixed a bug where clipboard transfer could be blocked by cursor updates.
 - Fixed a bug where dead connections could crash Vine Viewer.
 - Fixed a bug where Vine Viewer would lock up on a clipboard "Cycle" between servers.
 - Removed some debugging console logs.
 - Fixed a bug with the Connection List not always showing all available Bonjour servers.
 - Fixed a problem with entries in the Connection List not always indicating the proper state after a connection is lost.
 - Fixed a problem when changing color depth would disconnect a connection.
 - Fixed a problem with restoring a connection when re-launching if it's a Bonjour entry.

Release v1.1 (5-December-2006)

Highlights:

- Enhanced control over connection availability checks:
 - You can manually trigger an update at any time from the Connection menu or the context menu in the connection list.
 - Added the ability to exclude individual connections from having their availability checked.
 - From the General Preferences you can set it to update once when you first start up. This is now the default.These options are especially useful when working with RealVNC 4.1 servers, since repeated polling will cause a security lock-out until the server is restarted.
- Added the option to manually set the display name for each connection when adding or editing a connection.
- Added support for mouse buttons 3, 6, 7, and 8 on multi-button mice. (Buttons 4 and 5 are used internally by VNC for scroll wheel support, so can not be passed through directly.)
- A license management feature has been added to the website.
 - This service allows users to retrieve their license keys and request a limited number of license transfers to new machines. This feature can be accessed by clicking the new "Manage" button on the Vine Licenses panel, or by visiting:

- A new version of Vine Server (v2.1) has also been released, which supports improvements to file copying to and from Vine Viewer (see the Vine Server Release Notes for full details).

Bug Fixes / Tweaks:

- Fixed problems with copying and pasting files between systems running different versions of Mac OS X (requires Vine Server 2.1 on the remote machine).
 - Fixed a problem where reverse connections didn't always update the screen properly.
 - Fixed a problem on Intel-based Macs where size of clipboard data wasn't reporting correctly. This would sometimes result in a progress sheet being displayed whenever text was copied.
 - Fixed a problem with turning off the SSH (secure connection) option for a connection.
 - Fixed the Disconnect button to do a better job of canceling a connection in progress.
 - Fixed several crashing bugs.
 - Fixed several compatibility problems on Mac OS X 10.3 with sorting connections and editing connections.
 - Fixed a problem in which the remote window would sometimes stop tracking mouse movements after Vine had been hidden and then made active again.
 - Improved Bonjour lookups.
 - Fixed some performance problems after establishing/closing many connections.

Release v1.0 (1-November-2006)

Highlights:

- Rich Clipboard Support -- Copy and Paste almost anything, Images, rich text, Files in the Finder. (Requires Vine Server 2.0)
 - Easy integration with SSH for secure connections.
 - QuickTime movie recording.
 - Screen Capture.
 - Remote screen scaling.
 - Right Click Mouse Emulation
 - Remote screen toolbar with common functions.
 - VNC support for 32-bit, 16-bit and 8-bit connections, various color formats, supported with all encodings.
 - Convenient connection list to organize and initiate multiple simultaneous connections.
 - Availability of VNC servers updates automatically.
 - Integration with Redstone Store, try it using the "Try Now" or "Buy Now" links on the License Panel.
